

1. For courses, which there are no students in the waiting list the colleges can consider students who have not opted the college or course.
2. For courses, with insufficient students in the waiting list the colleges can consider students who have not opted the college or course. A separate rank list shall be prepared for the students included in the waiting list and for those who have not opted the college or course. First preference shall be given to the candidates included in the waiting list.
3. In case, for any course if the waiting list provided exhaust, then also the colleges can consider students not opted the college or course. A separate rank list shall be prepared for those who have not opted the college or course.
4. Students without a valid printout of the CAP registration for UG programmes 2018 admission should not be admitted at any cost.
5. The CAP generation for lakshadweep students without fee payment will be available in the college login from 12.07.2018. The colleges can generate CAP ID and password for the students and then login in the registration link and complete the application process.
6. Manadatory fee for all admissions shall be remitted in the purpose code **UGSW2018- UG CAP2018 MANDATORY FEE FOR ALL ADMISSIONS.**
7. The candidates included in more than one waiting list can report for admission through representatives.
8. All fees collected from the students at the time of admissions shall be refunded while issuing TC, by the colleges as shown in the table.

9. All documents collected from the students at the time of admissions shall be returned while issuing TC, by the colleges.
10. In the case of admission as mentioned in item no. 2 and 3 college, shall advertise the vacancies, date for reporting and admission date in the leading dailies, but within the dates earmarked for admission in the schedule.
