Applications are invited for the available vacant seats in two-year (4 semester) MBA programmes, MBA (Health Care) and MBA (International Finance) for the Academic year 2019-20 at the Department of Commerce and Management Studies (DCMS) and at the Self Financing centres under the Department. Applications are also invited for admission to the merit seats of management institutes/colleges affiliated to the University (please see the list of MBA colleges - Annexure I) and for the Part-time MBA (Evening programme - Self Financing - 4 semesters). If sufficient No. of candidates do not prefer any of the centres for the MBA evening programme, the programme will not be offered at that centre.

Candidates seeking admission under Management quota in self financing colleges shall also register online under the University, though the admission of such candidates is directly done by the colleges/institutions concerned.

Eligibility

Any degree of the University of Calicut (including degree Programmes of the SDE/Open Degree programme of SDE, University of Calicut) or that of any other University or Institute or Institution recognized by the UGC or AICTE. Programmes of other Universities or Institutions shall be in 10+2+3 pattern (or 10+2+4) under regular stream. In all the cases, the student should have passed the Bachelor Degree examination with not less than 50% marks in aggregate, including the marks of the languages, if any. OBC and SC/ST students are allowed relaxation in marks as per rules (i.e.; 5% relaxation for OBC & Other Eligible Communities and a mere pass for SC/ST).

Applicant must obtain the minimum score required either in the CMAT conducted by AICTE, KMAT conducted by ASC, Thiruvananthapuram or CAT conducted by IIMs.

Two years' work experience is required for MBA evening programme in addition to the other requirements. In the absence of adequate number of applicants with two year's experience, others would also be considered.

Selection

Selection will be based on the score obtained for the year 2019 either in the CMAT conducted by AICTE, KMAT conducted by the ASC, Thiruvananthapuram, or CAT conducted by IIMs and the score obtained in the GD and Personal Interview conducted by the University of Calicut. The minimum score required for the above tests for calling for Group Discussion and Personal Interview is 15% for general candidates, 10% for OBC & SEBC and 7.5% for SC/ST candidates.

How to Apply

1. Remit application fee of Rs. 835/- (SC/ST Rs.467/-) to the Calicut University Fund by State Bank online/Friends/Akshaya E Challan. Apply online through the website www.cuonline.ac.in (see

the link “ Entrance Courses” for submitting online application. Select the purpose “Application fee for MBA Admission 2019 with late fee” while processing the Chalan).

2. The applicants shall send the print out of the application along with the original challan receipt and a self addressed, Rs. 5/- stamped envelope (26cmx15cm) directly to **Professor and Head, Department of Commerce and Management Studies, University of Calicut, Malappuram 673 635**. **Do not attach any testimonials or copies of testimonials with the application. (A copy of the community certificate should be attached by SC/ST applicants.)**

3. **Last date for online registration and receipt of the print out of the application is 5.00 PM on 09.07.2019 (Tuesday).**

4 . **The candidate must mention the online registration ID Number in all future communications. Please note that CAP ID is mandatory for downloading Hall Tickets.**

5. The applicants shall update themselves with the University website www.cuonline.ac.in or www.uoc.ac.in and the University press releases for the latest information relating the Counselling, Personal Interview, admission, etc.
