**NOTIFICATION FOR ADMISSION TO UG PROGRAMMES WITH ENTRANCE EXAMINATION (2019-20)**

Applications are invited for admission to the BHM, BPEd (Integrated), BPEd (2years) and B.Com (Honours) Programmes of this University for the Academic year 2019-20. The details of the courses and the institutions are given below.

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**Conditions and Guidelines:-**

1. A fee of Rs. 350/- (SC/ST Rs.150/-) for one programme shall be remitted to Calicut University Fund by e-payment (SBI online/SBI e-chalan/Friends/Akshaya e-chalan/Payment gateway). Please click the link "fee remittance" in the Admission Website ([www.cuonline.ac.in](http://www.cuonline.ac.in)) or the link "Instant Web Payment System" in the Official Website of the University ([www.uoc.ac.in](http://www.uoc.ac.in)) for remitting fee. Choose the purpose of remittance while processing the challan. Candidate should have to pay an additional fee of Rs.50/- for each additional programme.
2. The ethnic native Lakshadweep candidates are exempted from the entrance examinations based on the sponsorship letter from the Lakshadweep administration, subject to eligibility (U.O. No:14933/2016/Admn dated 26.12.2016).
3. Apply online (from 22.03.2019 to 12.04.2019) through the website [www.cuonline.ac.in](http://www.cuonline.ac.in). Click on the link 'Entrance Courses ". Enter CAP ID number and pass word and go ahead for completing the registration process. ( Last date for remittance of registration fee :12.04.2019)
4. After completion of the online registration, the candidate should take printout of the same and keep it with himself/herself. **DO NOT SEND HARD COPIES OF THE PRINT OUT OF ONLINE APPLICATION OR ANY OTHER DOCUMENTS TO THE UNIVERSITY.** The hard copy of the online application with supporting documents should be kept by the candidate and it has to be submitted at the time of admission to respective departments. The CAP ID.No. is mandatory for downloading hall tickets for the entrance examinations. This I.D.No should also be kept and mentioned by the candidate in all future communications. **Candidates have to retain the CAP ID as well as the password for this purpose.**
5. Those who are awaiting the results of the qualifying examination can also apply. They have to submit the copies of Marklist/Grade card to the Head/Director/ Co-ordinator, as the case may be, in order to finalise the Rank list within the stipulated time.
6. Candidates coming under SC/ST/OEC/SEBC are not eligible for BPL reservation. Only the general category candidates belonging to the Forward communities, who are economically backward, are eligible for BPL reservation. A certificate from the Local Self Govt. authorities to that effect has to be produced at the time of admission.
7. Candidates are permitted to submit marklist/grade card of the qualifying examination at least 45 days from the commencement of class for the programme if admission is based on marks of the entrance examination only.
8. For preparing ranklist by considering the marks/grades of qualifying examination, a **window will be opened for entering the qualifying exam marks by the candidates, the time limit for the window to be opened will be based on the availability of plus two certificate. The candidates those who fails to enter the qualifying examination marks in the website within the stipulated time will not be included in the ranklist.**
9. The Heads/Co-ordinators are authorized to conduct Entrance and admissions as per rules and allot students to affiliated colleges/Centres.
10. Allotment to the affiliated colleges will be made to fill the merit seat.
11. **All candidates seeking admission including those who seek admission under Management quota in affiliated/self financing colleges shall register online and appear for the entrance examination. Admission can only be made from the ranklist prepared by the University including management seat. The candidates who seek admission under management quota shall produce a copy of the print out of the online application at the college where they propose to take admission.**

12. No memo will be sent to the candidates in respect of entrance examination, entrance examination result, Counselling etc. Candidates shall update themselves with the University Website ([www.cuonline.ac.in/www.uoc.ac.in](http://www.cuonline.ac.in/www.uoc.ac.in)) and the University Press releases for the latest information.
13. Tentative schedule of Entrance examination is given as Annexure No I. The schedule may change due to unforeseen reasons.
14. The admission committee constituted by the Department Council will conduct the entrance examination and admission for UG courses offered at the Departments.
15. The type of questions can be objective only, descriptive only or a combination of objective and descriptive questions. If the entrance examination includes objective type questions alone, 1/3 marks will be deducted for each wrong answer. If it includes combination of objective type and descriptive type questions or descriptive questions only no negative scores, that is, no deduction of marks for wrong answers.
16. The admitted candidates shall provide marklist of the qualifying examination at least 45 days from the date of admission, otherwise the student concerned should relinquish the seat. Students should provide a signed declaration in this regard at the time of admission.
17. The duration of the entrance examination will be 2 hours.
18. There will be entrance examination centres at Thrissur and Calicut University. If a student intend to appear for the entrance examination in more than one programme, he/she should opt only a single centre for all the programmes. However the centre opted by an applicant is only his/her option. But the University may allot a different Centre either due to shortage of applicants or any other reasons. Actual centre will be allotted by University of Calicut which will be the final. The exact venue, date and time of the Entrance Examination will be there in the Hall Ticket which has to be downloaded by the applicant from the University admission website.
19. No fees other than those prescribed by the University/Govt. shall be levied from the students. (U.O.No:520/2019/Admn dated 14.01.2019 & Circular No:1680/DOA-ASST-2/2015/Admn, dated 08.02.2019).
20. The Mandatory Reservation Rules of Admission in the Aided colleges/ Self Financing colleges are shown as Annexure II
21. **Claim for Communal reservation under 'Socially and Educationally Backward Classes' (SEBC):** Reservation of seats to the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes will be in accordance with the provisions contained in G.O. (P) 208/66/Edn. Dated 2.5.1966, and G.O. (P) 2/2017BCDD, Dated 8.3.2017 as amended from time to time. Candidates belonging to Ezhava, Muslim, Other Backward Hindus, Latin Catholic other than Anglo Indians and Other Backward Christian communities, claiming reservation under SEBC Quota should invariably produce both **community and non-creamy layer certificates** obtained from the Village Officer/Thahsildar and should be produced at the time of admission. Candidates whose annual family income is above the amount stipulated by the Govt. for this purpose from time to time are not eligible for reservation. The seats unavailed by SEBC category candidates will be allotted under open quota.
22. **Claim for Reservation under Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes Quota:** Candidates claiming reservation under Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes quota should obtain the Caste/Community Certificate from the Tahsildar. The seats unavailed by the SC candidates will go to ST candidates and vice versa.
23. **Claim of OEC candidates against the un-availed seats of SC/ST candidates:** Other Eligible Community (OEC) candidates who claim allotment to the un-availed seats, if any, under SC/ST quota should furnish Community and Income certificates obtained from the Village Officer concerned. Those OEC candidates whose annual family income is up to the amount stipulated by the Govt. for this purpose from time to time alone are eligible for

such seats.

**24. Mandatory fee:** After admission in the University Department or online allotment to the affiliated colleges, the prescribed Mandatory Fee due to the University as detailed below will have to be remitted by the candidate through e-payment within the time prescribed to claim the allotment. For SC/ST Candidates, Rs 115/- . For Others, Rs 480/-.

**25. Refund of fee collected:** The UGC guidelines for the refund of fees collected from the students at the time of admission, is shown below (as per U.O.No:11428/2018/Admn, dated 29.09.2018).

**\*For the limited purpose of reservation, under this category, candidates belonging to all those communities which do not enjoy communal reservation will be eligible. Candidates who wish to avail reservation under EBFC will have to produce at the time of admission the Certificate that they come Under the Below Poverty Line (BPL) category of forward communities, obtained from the local bodies concerned and community certificate from the village offices.**

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**The seats under community quota shall be reserved for students of the community to which the college belongs and such seats shall be filled on the basis of merit. The seats under management quota shall be filled by the management from among candidates of their choice provided that they satisfy the eligibility condition prescribed by the University.**

**In the case of Unaided Colleges and Self Financing programmes conducted in Aided Colleges, 50% of the total seats shall be filled by the management from among candidates of their choice provided they satisfy the eligibility conditions. The remaining seats (50%) shall be distributed and filled as follows:**
