Applications are invited for

1. Available vacant seats in two-year (4 semester) MBA programmes, MBA (Health Care) and MBA (International Finance) for the Academic year 2020-21 at the Department of Commerce and Management Studies (DCMS) and at the Self Financing centres under the Department: and
2. For admission to the merit seats of management institutes/colleges affiliated to the University (please see the list of MBA colleges/SMS Centres in - Annexure I) and for the Part-time MBA (Evening programme - Self Financing - 4 semesters). If sufficient number of candidates do not prefer any of the centres for the MBA evening programme, the programme will not be offered at that centre.

Candidates seeking admission under Management quota in self financing colleges shall also register online under the University, though the admission of such candidates is directly done by the colleges/institutions concerned.

Last Date of Online Registration 13.07.2020

Eligibility

Any degree of the University of Calicut (including degree Programmes of the SDE/Open Degree programme of SDE, University of Calicut) or that of any other University or Institute or Institution recognized by the UGC or AICTE. Programmes of other Universities or Institutions shall be in 10+2+3 pattern (or 10+2+4) under regular stream. In all the cases, the student should have passed the Bachelor Degree examination with not less than 50% marks in aggregate, including the marks of the languages, if any. OBC and SC/ST students are allowed relaxation in marks as per rules (i.e.; 5% relaxation for OBC & Other Eligible Communities and a mere pass for SC/ST).

Applicant must obtain the minimum score required either in the CMAT conducted by AICTE, KMAT conducted by ASC, Thiruvananthapuram or CAT conducted by IIMs.

Two years' work experience is required for MBA evening programme in addition to the other requirements. In the absence of adequate number of applicants with two year's experience, others would also be considered.

Applicants awaiting their degree results may also apply. However, **Original qualifying degree mark list should be submitted before 30.09.2020.**

Selection

Selection will be based on the score obtained for the year 2020 either in the CMAT conducted by AICTE, KMAT conducted by ASC, Thiruvananthapuram, or CAT conducted by IIMs. The minimum score required for the above tests for eligibility : 15% for General category 10% for OBC & SEBC and 7.5% for SC/ST candidates.

How to Apply

1. First Step - CAP ID Creation : Candidate applying for MBA 2020 shall initially create a CAP ID by providing the basic details using the "New User (Create CAP ID)" link provided in the MBA 2020 registration page. After successful submission of the details, a CAP ID and Password will be sent to the registered mobile number instantly (Mobile number of students/ parents/guardian only to be furnished).
2. Second Step - Registration Completion and Making Payment: With the CAP ID and Password received in the registered mobile number, the candidate can login and fill the registration page by providing required data. Candidates shall take utmost care while selecting the reservation category during the filling up of registration data. For completing the registration, candidate shall click on the " Finalise & Proceed to Payment " button and make payment.
3. An application fee of Rs. 555/- for General Category and Rs.187/-for SC/ST Category will have to be paid by the candidates for completing the registration procedure.
4. During the payment, the website will be redirected to the University of Calicut Instant Web Payment System (CUIWPS) page where the student can select the desired choice of payment. After successful payment, candidates can take the print out of application after re-login by using the CAP ID and Password provided earlier. (In case, the payment fails, the candidate will have to re-login and do the payment procedure once again to complete the payment and obtain the printout of the application). Print out of the application will be provided only if the payment is successful.
5. Candidate's application will be considered complete only if he/she has completed the above mentioned steps and is holding a finalised printout showing approved stamp on the candidate's photo.
6. The applicants shall send the print out of the application along with the original challan receipt and a self addressed, Rs. 5/- stamped envelope (26cmx15cm) directly to **Professor and Head, Department of Commerce and Management Studies, University of Calicut, Malappuram 673 635**. **Do not attach any testimonials or copies of testimonials with the application. (A copy of the community certificate should be attached by SC/ST applicants.)**
7. **Last date for receipt of the print out of the application is 5.00 PM on 14.07.2020 (Tuesday).**
8. **The candidate must mention the CAP ID Number in all future communications.**
9. The applicants shall update themselves with the University website www.cuonline.ac.in or www.uoc.ac.in and the University press releases for the latest information relating the Counselling, Admission etc.
