

UNIVERSITY OF CALICUT**NOTIFICATION FOR ADMISSION TO PG PROGRAMMES IN AFFILIATED COLLEGES 2020 - 21**

Online Applications are invited for admission to Post Graduate Programmes in Affiliated colleges of the University of Calicut for the academic year 2020-2021.

All candidates seeking admission to PG programmes irrespective of the Quota (General merit/Reservation/Sports/Persons with disabilities/Kashmir Students/Tamil Linguistic Minority/Community/ Management etc.) should compulsorily register through **Centralised Admission Process (CAP)**. **The candidates who have not registered through CAP will not be permitted to take admission at any stage of the admission process.**

For Non English candidates applying for M A English, admission will be based on Entrance Test. The candidates who studied B A Degree in Thullal, Mohiniyattam, Bharatanatyam and Koodiyattam are eligible for admission to MA Sanskrit through Entrance Test. The University will conduct the above entrance examination considering the COVID19 situation.

I) Admissions to Programmes which come under the purview of Centralised Allotment**Centralised Admission Process**

Allotment to the seats under the merit/reservation quota is conducted through Centralised Allotment. Selection/Allotment of a candidate to a particular programme to any College will be based on the rank of the candidate and the availability of the seat.

II) Details of seats that comes under the ambit of Centralised Allotment

2	Aided Colleges	Open Quota Seats (Merit) and seats reserved for Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes .
3	Unaided Colleges & Self Financing Courses in Aided Colleges	50% of the total seats including the seats reserved for SC/ST/SEBC.

4	IHRD Self Financing Colleges	50% of the seats (including the seats reserved for SC/ST/SEBC) subject to the reservation rules of Government/University.

III) Mode of Registration

Mode of Registration : Online

The Online registration will commence on 27.08.2020, 5 pm onwards and ends on 14.09.2020, 5 pm.

Steps for Online Registration is provided in the Prospectus for PG Centralised Admission Process 2020-21 available in the website www.cuonline.ac.in

The Online registration through Centralised Admission Process will be conducted in Single stage.

IV) Payment of Online Registration Fees

The fee for online registration can be remitted from 27.08.2020 onwards. Last date for Fee payment will be 14.09.2020, 5 pm

Payment of fee for online registration can be made only through e-payment system (SBI Online/ Payment Gateway/ Nodal Centres functioning in Affiliated Colleges/ Friends Janasevana Kendram/ Akshaya Kendras). Printout of the application will be provided only if the payment is successful.

Online Registration Fees: For SC/ST :Rs 115 /-, For Others: Rs.280/-

Important Note:- Application fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstances.

V) Eligibility for Admission and Index of Marks

Candidates registering their options, should satisfy all the eligibility criteria with regard to the academic qualifications prescribed in the eligibility criteria and indexing rules for admission to various courses published in the website before starting of the registration.

VI) Allotments

There will be two allotments for GOVERNMENT, AIDED and UNAIDED COLLEGES prior to commencement of classes.

VII) Mandatory fee

After the allotment, the prescribed Mandatory Fee due to the University as detailed below will have to be remitted by the candidate through e-payment within the time prescribed to claim the allotment. **The candidates failing to do so will loose his/her current allotment and they will be expelled from further allotments.**

Rs 115/- for SC/ST/OEC-SC/OEC-ST/COMMUNITIES ELIGIBLE FOR EDUCATIONAL CONCESSIONS AS IS GIVEN TO OEC Candidates.

Rs 480/- for Others.

(The SC/ST/OEC-SC/OEC-ST/COMMUNITIES ELIGIBLE FOR EDUCATIONAL CONCESSIONS AS IS GIVEN TO OEC candidates taking admission to the programmes without fee concession at Aided/Self Financing colleges should remit Sports Affiliation Fee (Rs.280/-) and University Union fee (Rs. 85/-) at the college while taking admission.)
