NOTIFICATION FOR ADMISSION TO M.PHIL PROGRAMME - 2020

Applications are invited from eligible candidates including candidates exempted from entrance test for admission to the M.Phil programmes in the University Teaching Departments and Govt College Chittur for the following subjects: Arabic, Malayalam, Sanskrit, Hindi, Tamil, English, Botany, Zoology, Physics, Chemistry, Life Sciences (Physiology, Microbiology and Biochemistry), Biotechnology, Statistics, Mathematics, Library and Information Science, Computer Science, Psychology, Economics, Education, History, Journalism & Mass Communication, Women's Studies, Philosophy, Theatre Arts, Folklore Studies and Commerce.

Candidates should verify vacancy position published in www.cuonline.ac.in, before applying.

1. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

1.1 Candidates for admission to the M.Phil. programme shall have a Masters degree or a professional degree declared equivalent to the Masters degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7 point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.

1.2 A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (noncreamy layer)/ Differently-abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the UGC from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Masters degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedures.

1.3 PG result awaiting students can also apply for the Entrance Examination of M.Phil for the academic year 2020-21. An online platform for uploading the PG results will be made available in the admission website and the students has to upload their PG marks/grade as per the consolidated grade card in the online platform on or before 24th June 2020.

2. ENTRANCE TEST

2.1 Candidates eligible for registration to M.Phil. shall be decided by an Entrance Test. Entrance Test shall be conducted at the University Departments on the dates notified.

2.2 A minimum of 40% marks in entrance test is necessary for qualifying the Entrance. Admission shall be made from the rank list based on the percentage of marks/grade. Admission is possible only against the notified vacancies.

2.3 Rank list will be prepared on the basis of the percentage of marks/grade obtained in the entrance test alone (UO.No. 6303/2019/Admn dated 16.05.2019).

2.4 Syllabus of the Entrance Test will be only from the concerned PG syllabus, with 50% objective and 50% descriptive questions.

3. EXEMPTION FROM ENTRANCE TEST

UGC- CSIR - JRF Fellowship holders are exempted from Entrance Test and 1 (one) seat will be reserved for JRF holders.

4. DURATION OF THE PROGRAMME

M.Phil. programme shall be for a minimum duration of two consecutive semesters/one year.

5. COURSE WORK

The details of course work can be had from Regulations for Award of M.Phil Degrees - University of Calicut 2018 which is uploaded in the website www.cuonline.ac.in

6. PROCEDURE OF APPLICATION

6.1 Applications can be submitted online from 25.05.2020 to 05.06.2020 midnight.

First Step - CAP ID Creation : Candidate applying for M.Phil 2020 shall initially create a CAP ID by providing the basic details using the "New User (Create CAP ID)" link provided in the M.Phil 2020 registration page. After successful submission of the details, a CAP ID and Password will be sent to the registered mobile number instantly (Mobile number of students/ parents/ guardian only to be furnished).

6.2 Second Step - Registration Completion and Making Payment: With the CAP ID and Password received in the registered mobile number, the candidate can login and fill the registration page by providing required data. Candidates shall take utmost care while selecting the reservation category during the filling up of registration data. For completing the registration, candidate shall click on the " Finalise & Proceed to Payment " button and make payment.

6.3 An application and entrance examination fee of Rs. 555/- for General Category and Rs.190/- for SC/ST Category will have to be paid by the candidates for completing the registration procedure.

6.4 During the payment, the website will be redirected to the University of Calicut Instant Web Payment System (CUIWPS) page where the student can select the desired choice of payment. After successful payment, candidates can take the print out of application after re-login by using the CAP ID and Password provided earlier. (In case, the payment fails, the candidate will have to re-login and do the payment procedure once again to complete the payment and obtain the print out of the application). Print out of the application will be provided only if the payment is successful.

6.5 Candidate's application will be considered complete only if he/she has completed the above mentioned steps and is holding a finalised printout showing approved stamp on the candidate's photo.

6.6 All Candidates including entrance exempted candidates, shall register online for seeking admission to M.Phil programme 2020.

6.7 Printouts of the M.Phil applications shall not be sent by the applicants to the concerned departments. Instead, the application printouts may be submitted by the students at the time of admission at the departments.

7. HALL TICKETS FOR ENTRANCE EXAMINATION.

CAP ID allotted during the registration process is mandatory for downloading hall tickets for the entrance examinations. This CAP ID should be noted in all future communications by the candidate. The candidates can download hall tickets for the entrance examination from www.cuonline.ac.in (Please see the link 'Entrance Courses') 3 days before the date of entrance examination. No individual communication

regarding entrance exam will be sent to the candidates and the candidates shall go through the University Websites and the University Press release for the latest information.

8. RESERVATION

8.1 Reservation policy applicable to University Teaching Departments shall be followed at all the research departments/centres (UO.No.471/2020/Admn dated 14.01.2020)

8.2 Open quota and Mandatory reservation seats shall be distributed as follows:

* For the limited purpose of reservation, under this category, candidates belonging to all those communities which do not enjoy communal reservation will be eligible. Candidates who wish to avail reservation under EBFC will have to produce at the time of admission a Certificate that they come under the Below Poverty Line (BPL) category of forward communities, obtained from the local self government concerned and community certificate from the village officer.

8.3 Special Reservation:- 5% of seats will be set apart for the PwD (Persons with Disabilities) category, within the sanctioned seats, for M.Phil.
